

RESEARCH INTERN (REMOTE)

The National Breast Cancer Coalition seeks a driven, results-oriented intern to assist with research projects and scientific research analysis.

Since 1991, The National Breast Cancer Coalition has been at the vanguard of the breast cancer movement – elevating breast cancer to an issue of national significance, leveraging billions of federal dollars for research and care, and empowering tens of thousands of breast cancer survivors to become effective advocates for themselves, and all those at risk of breast cancer. NBCC is the organization that will end breast cancer; we are activists who set a research agenda to ensure that outcome, who tell the truth about breast cancer, upend the status quo, and empower survivors to be leaders for this cause.

Primary Purpose: The research internship is an opportunity to build and strengthen professional skills particularly in science research, analysis of scientific information, writing, organization and interpersonal communications.

Duties include:

- Conduct background research (including literature reviews) and analysis to develop factsheets, update position statements, craft science/issue briefs and other resources on a variety of issue areas related to breast cancer, and other projects as they arise.
- Other responsibilities may include supporting grassroots advocacy efforts.

Candidates should also have:

- Excellent written and communication skills
- Research and analysis experience
- Strong interest in Research & Advocacy

The ideal candidate is a current undergraduate or graduate student. To qualify, you must be pursuing a degree, certificate or diploma (full time or part time), and be in good academic standing at your school.

The position requires:

- Strong writing and oral communications skills
- A desire to learn as well as dedication to the internship, and a strong work ethic
- Ability to work independently with great attention to detail
- Professional attitude and timely delivery of projects
- Must be able to intern at least two (partial or full) days a week
