Dear Friends,

Welcome to our annual Cabaret, *Les Girls*. It has been a very different world for the past couple of years and tonight we should celebrate life. We look forward to another evening of exciting, witty, and tantalizing fun for a great cause.

The National Breast Cancer Coalition (NBCC) has accomplished a great deal over the past 30 years and has worked tirelessly to identify and eliminate the obstacles to ending breast cancer. We have tackled the big issues in breast cancer, challenged the status quo, and faced controversy head on. We continue to have a real impact. The reality is that in this country alone, this year we will lose 43,600 women and 530 men to breast cancer. And worldwide that number will be 685,000 women. We can all agree that this is unacceptable.

Since 1991, NBCC has been at the vanguard of the breast cancer movement, elevating breast cancer to an issue of national significance. NBCC brought about a federal breast cancer research program that has resulted in over \$3.9 billion for the worldwide scientific community. On behalf of the hundreds of breast cancer organizations and tens of thousands of advocates who are part of NBCC, as well as the more than 3.8 million individuals in the United States living with breast cancer, those at risk, and their family and friends, thank you for your support and generosity.

I also want to congratulate and thank the *Les Girls* committee members who helped plan and organize this evening and whose work ensures the event's success year after year. We are grateful to you for all that you do and your unwavering support. And, many thanks to our honorees, Alec Call and Bryan Johns for their many years of support for our cause and Sherry Goldman for her advocacy on behalf of NBCC. We also share our deep appreciation to the crew and members of the cast, all of whom donated their time. Thank you for sharing your extraordinary talents with us and making this evening such a success.

It has been 40 years since Sherry Goldman began her journey as a medical provider in the area of women's health. She had her family at a very young age and has now been married to Barry for over 50 years with a blended family of 7 children and lots of extended family. After she had her last child, she went back to school, earning an RN and a bachelor's degree and then on to a master's nurse practitioner program at UCLA in women's health. She joined an Ob-Gyn practice, until Susan Love, M.D. asked her

to join the team to open a new breast center at UCLA. Susan introduced Sherry to NBCC very shortly after its inception. The people in the organization stole her heart, instantly, with their advocacy work and determination to end breast cancer. Sherry was diagnosed with breast cancer after she became involved in the cause and remained at UCLA for nearly 19 years. She became more and more involved with NBCC by representing UCLA on the NBCC Board of Directors. During that time, she took Project LEAD®, mentored other advocates, served as an advocate reviewer for the Department of Defense Breast Cancer Research Program for breast cancer research projects, and served on various committees, including the Les Girls Committee. Ten years ago, Armando Giuliano recruited Sherry to the Cedars-Sinai Breast Center, and she now represents Cedars on the NBCC Board of Directors. She is dedicated to her breast cancer patients and advocacy work. One of her greatest wishes is to see the end of breast cancer in her lifetime. She personally feels the only organization who has come close to achieving this goal is NBCC and is proud to be a part of it.
