Welcome to Les Girls Cabaret 2022! As many of you know, this event never disappoints. Before you sit back and enjoy an evening of talented performances, laughter, and fun, I would be remiss if I didn't share my thanks with each and every one of you for being here tonight.

Many of you have been staunch supporters of NBCC for decades. Many of you donate your time and your resources to make this event a success every year. Many of you are dedicated, much like me, to our mission to end breast cancer. Unfortunately, many of us know all too well the impact of this disease. I want to assure you that NBCC will not let up in our work to end breast cancer. We will lead innovative research, educate and train advocates, and expand access for the underserved. We couldn't do this important work without you. And we will not stop until there is an end to breast cancer.

Thanks to the extraordinary efforts of our Event Committee, the support from our sponsors, the personal commitment of our host and performers, and the creativity of our production team, we are all able to come together to celebrate NBCC's 2022 successes.

NBCC again secured \$150 million in funding for the worldwide scientific community, through the Department of Defense breast cancer research program, totaling more than \$4 billion to date. Through our Artemis Project[®], we led a collaboration of exceptional scientists and dedicated advocates who are about to begin a Phase-1 clinical trial on a breast cancer preventive vaccine, and we have made inroads in understanding the process of metastasis. We trained more than 200 advocates in the science and policy of breast cancer and continue to push Congress to pass the Metastatic Breast Cancer Access to Care Act.

The Les Girls Cabaret event allows NBCC to continue this life-saving work. On behalf of the hundreds of breast cancer organizations and tens of thousands of advocates who are part of NBCC, thank you all for being here and supporting our work.

The more than three million women and thousands of men in the United States living with breast cancer, those at risk, and their families and friends, are relying on us to save future generations from breast cancer. Together, tonight, we will make a difference, for them.

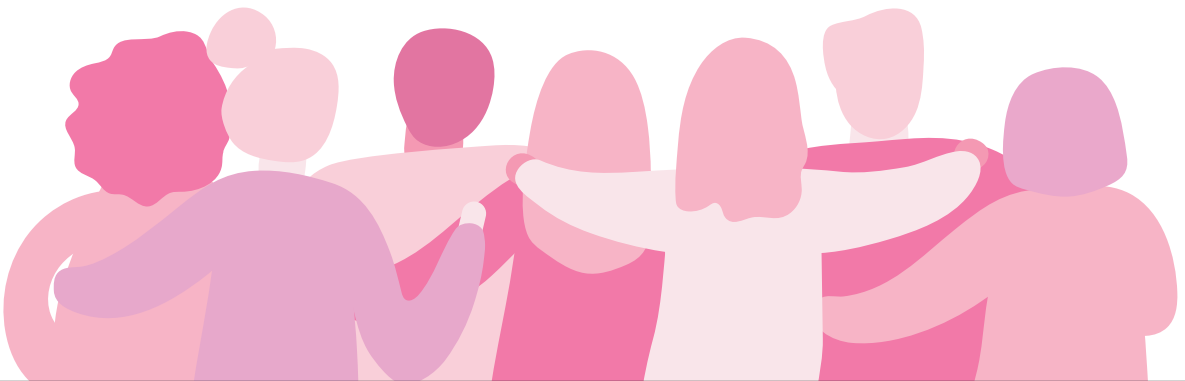
