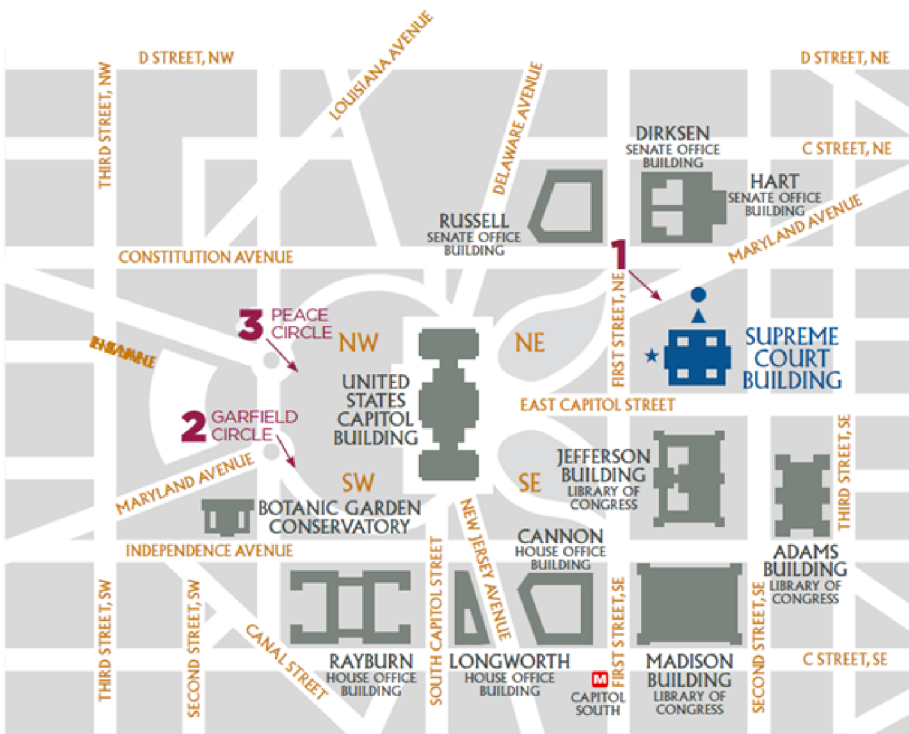


TUESDAY DETAILS

- **BUS/MORNING DROP-OFF:** There will be one bus at 8am and another at 8:30am (ADA accessible) to take Lobby Day participants from the Park Hyatt Hotel to Capitol Hill. Participants should meet in the Park Hyatt lobby, where a Hosts DC representative will direct you to the buses. The drop-off location is on the southeast side of the US Capitol at Garfield Circle. NBCC's base of operations for the entire Lobby Day will be the ROA building (1 Constitution Ave. NE, Washington, DC 20002). Breakfast and lunch will be available. (See map on back.)
- **MORNING HOTEL CHECK-OUTS AND DEPARTING DC AFTER LOBBY DAY:** Before boarding the bus to Capitol Hill, drop your luggage off in Salon 4-5 in the hotel **NO LATER than 8:15am**. A valet service will receive and check luggage and transport it to the ROA building. Luggage can be picked up from the ROA Building atrium after 12:30pm, but **NO LATER than 6:00pm**.
- **DEPARTING CAPITOL HILL BEFORE 12:30PM:** You must transport your own luggage to the ROA building to ensure you have it at your departure time.
- **EVENING BUS PICK-UP TO RETURN TO HOTEL:** The bus will depart promptly at 6:15pm on the Senate side of the US Capitol at Peace Circle and return to the Park Hyatt.

What can I expect at the meetings with my Members of Congress? Your Team Leader and/or attending NBCC staff are responsible for running the meeting and presenting NBCC's agenda to your Member of Congress or Legislative Assistant. Follow their lead and guidance. You should come prepared with general knowledge about NBCC's 2024 Legislative and Public Policy Priorities as well as a few points you would like to share about your personal connection to breast cancer.

When is the reception honoring Rep. Anna Eshoo? If you have RSVP'ed to attend the reception, please make your way to 2075 Rayburn between 4-6pm, ensuring you leave enough time to pick up your luggage at the ROA building and/or board the return bus to the hotel no later than 6pm.
