- Conducting congressional candidate research and outreach in key states.
- Assisting in legislative research and tracking related to breast cancer priorities.
- Conduct advocacy outreach related to federal appropriations for breast cancer research.
- Attending departmental and all staff meetings.
- Supporting other teams as needed.
- Performing administrative duties and keeping teams informed of progress on the above.

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate BA/BS degree program, or graduate program.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Ability to proactively manage multiple tasks.
